This past weekend, the TMC-WV squad competed in several significant events. TMC-WV is a nationally recognized bicycle racing team, competing in road, mountain bike and cyclocross disciplines. The Annual St. Patrick Race in Branchbrook Park, Newark, NJ was held on Saturday, March 18th. Despite the somewhat challenging conditions, close to two hundred riders attended the race where the temperatures were in the 30’s. In the Pro /1/2/3 category, TMC-WV’s Troy Kimball, took first place, his second victory in as many weeks and his first Pro 1/2/3 victory of his career. Controlling the field behind, TMC-WV’s Roger Aspholm took 2nd place behind Troy, giving the Team another one-two sweep of the hotly contested race.

In Category 3 racing, TMC-WV’s Kenneth Lundgren finished third in the highly competitive category, while in Category 4 racing, TMC-WV’s Chris Chapman took first place honors escaping with a small group early and later powering home solo. Capping off a strong showing at the Annual St. Patrick Race, Greg McGinley took second place in fast Category 5 sprint finish, his second 2nd place in as many weeks.

In another event elsewhere, the Johnny Cakes Series # 1 was held in Coxsackie, New York, featuring an extensive field of riders. TMC-WV’s Steve Goldman, and Chief Executive Officer of Trade Manage Capital, took 1st place in dramatic fashion. Steve attacked a field of more than 100 riders early in the race and then was joined by Dan Owens of CRBC. The two worked together in a 2-man break, holding off the main field for nearly 40 miles. In the final 2 km, Goldman attacked Owens who was unable to respond, giving Goldman his first victory of the year.

In California, Espen Kateraas, finished 5th in the brutally tough ”Ford ½ Ironman” competition. It was an amazing performance against some of the world’s best triathletes.

Once again, TMC-WV continues to post solid race results, the work product of hard work, proper training and team unity.
